### **KENYA GENERAL ELECTIONS, 9<sup>TH</sup> AUGUST 2022**

As we all know, the Kenya General Elections are scheduled for Tuesday 9 August 2022. Voters will elect the President, members of the National Assembly and Senate, County Governors and members of the 47 County Assemblies.
